This seems very restrictive and not consistent with other Federal procurements (DHS, USACE, NAVFAC, etc.) which normally consider projects with greater contract values as relevant because they demonstrate an Offeror has the ability to perform Task Order projects within the RFP's stated range. For example, if one of the five projects an Offeror submits is \$12M and it was design-build and included the majority of elements of work included in the RFP, it clearly demonstrates the Contractor has the capability, experience, and past performance required to perform a project that is \$10 million dollars. If this project was tossed out as not being relevant for consideration solely because it had a larger contract value, it would be an injustice. We request that the government reconsider the stipulation regarding relevancy for projects on the higher end with contract values larger than \$10 million.
